- OR current student in any design-related field
- OR a strong design portfolio demonstrating real skill (self-taught designers welcome)

- Any experience in design (NGO, freelance, academic, self-initiated projects all qualify)
- Prior experience creating social media graphics, posters, or digital layouts is an advantage
- A portfolio of at least 5–10 designs (Canva, Photoshop, Illustrator, or any platform)
